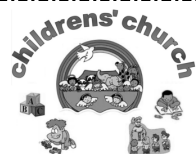

Dear Friends,

Praise the Lord! We are able to meet together though still only for one Sunday Service a week and we must continue to observe the Covid-19 safety protocols.

May is the month when we would traditionally celebrate our Church Anniversary – usually including a meal together. We are not able to do that this year but we will remember our 92<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary on the 9<sup>th</sup> May and thank the Lord for His faithfulness to His church here in Becontree Avenue.

The regulations are due to change again on 17<sup>th</sup> May (subject to government review) to allow gatherings of up to 30 people outdoors and, if all goes well, most of the remaining restrictions will be removed on 21<sup>st</sup> June although there is no ruling on indoor congregational singing yet. This means that we may be able to look forward to planning some happier events during the summer.
